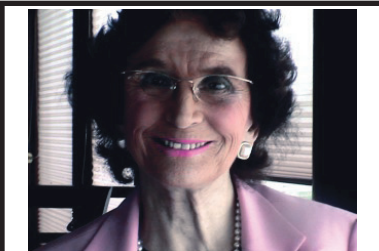


DELONG, Bernice Loretta
