MacDonald claims Rose City tennis crown

Brandon MacDonald defeated Vineland Tennis Club's Walter Garcia in three sets to win the final of the Rose City Iris Open tennis tournament last weekend in Welland.

After a 6-1 victory in the opening set of the final, MacDonald dropped a 6-0 decision in the second set before rebounding to down Garcia 6-3 in the third and decisive set.

"Walter plays a tough game," said MacDonald, who had lost to Garica in the quarter-finals of a tournament the previous week.
