MacDonald claims Rose City tennis crown

Brandon MacDonald defeated Vineland Tennis Club's Walter Garcia in three sets to win the final of the Rose City Iris Open tennis tournament last weekend in Welland.

After a 6-1 victory in the opening set of the final, MacDonald dropped a 6-0 decision in the second set before rebounding to down Garcia 6-3 in the third and decisive set.

"Walter plays a tough game," said MacDonald, who had lost to Garcia in the quarter-finals of a tournament the previous week.

The Rose City Iris Open marks

MacDonald's first Ontario Tennis Association tournament victory and second tournament title of the season.

Playing on the red clay of the Welland Tennis Club might have proved to be an advantage to the Xavier University junior.

"It suits my game, actually," said MacDonald, noting that the slow bounces on the clay catered to his controlled style and allowed him to sneak in some low slices.

Martin Beran, also of Oakville, was a semifinalist at the tournament. Beran fell 6-1, 6-3 to the top-seeded Garcia in the semis, while MacDonald bested Montreal's Christopher Audhuy 6-3, 6-1.

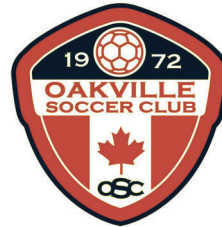
