

# Police issue warning after pills for treating seizures are lost

Halton police have issued a public safety alert after strong prescription medication was lost at Upper Middle and Trafalgar roads Thursday.

Police said a prescription bottle containing 57 Clonazepam pills (0.5 milligrams) was lost between

8:30 and 9:05 p.m.

Clonazepam is a benzodiazepine drug used for controlling certain types of seizures in the treatment of epilepsy and panic disorders.

The drug has anxiolytic, anticonvulsant, mus-

cle relaxant and hypnotic properties and should only be taken by people it is prescribed for.

Online warnings about the drug state overdosing on it could potentially result in a coma. The pills are orange in colour.

You are invited to attend and provide input at this public meeting hosted by Planning and Development Council. The Planning Services department will be presenting a recommendation report with respect to the development proposal at this meeting.

The purpose of this application is to create a common element condominium composed of a private road network, landscaping, visitors' parking, a community mailbox and a landscaping buffer area along Colonel William Parkway for the associated 89-unit townhouse development. These common features will be owned and maintained by the condominium corporation.

The subject parcel of land is bound to the north by Dundas Street West, to the west by Colonel William Parkway, to the south by future residential development and to the east by the Fourteen Mile Creek. The lands are described as Block 2, Plan 20M-1101 and Block 2, Plan 20M-1103 (formerly Part 5, Plan 20R-16163). At this time there are no other applications, under the Act, pertaining to the subject land.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at the public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Oakville in respect of the proposed plan of condominium before the approval authority gives or refuses to give approval to the draft plan of condominium:

a) the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Oakville, director of Planning Services, to the Ontario Municipal Board; and

b) the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

Any submission to the Planning and Development Council, either in hard copy or in electronic format, must be forwarded to the Clerk's department for receipt no later than noon on the day of the meeting to ensure its availability to the Members of Council at the meeting. Individuals making oral submissions at the public meeting are requested to submit a written outline of the submission to the Town Clerk. All submissions should include the full name and address of the presenter.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the director of Planning Services in respect of the proposed plan of condominium you must make a written request to the Director of Planning Services at the Town of Oakville, Planning Services department, 1225 Trafalgar Road, Oakville, ON L6H 0H3.
