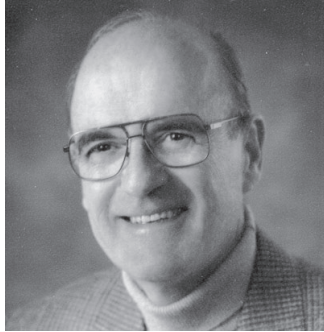


Obituaries
