tioning," Paniccia said. "He also helped me get more mentally prepared."

Paniccia is also entering her second season in the PWHL, where she posted a 2.55 average and .895 save percentage in 17 games last year with the Toronto Jr. Aeros. She's off to an even better start this season, allowing just three goals in winning her first two starts.

The 16-year-old also credits Aeros coach Darryl Gioncola for helping her improve her game.

"He knows what buttons to push," she said. "He says I'm not arrogant enough and tries to get me to play mad because he knows I play better that way."

As she does with the Aeros, Kennedy will be protecting the net in front of Paniccia. A rookie defenceman with the Aeros, the 16-year-old played for the Aeros' midget squad last season. Having to make decisions quicker has been the biggest difference she's noticed in the PWHL.

"It was tough the first couple of games," she said. "You have to do things quicker. You can see the play, you just have to make it in time."

Though Kennedy admits she didn't think her chances of making the team were that good, it helped to have Paniccia and Aeros teammate Jenna McParland at the tryouts with her.

"Everybody is playing at such a high caliber, it's tough to think you can do it," she said. "It helps if you've got others who have confidence in you. Just playing with people of that caliber is going to help."

Paniccia said she's never worried with Kennedy in front of her.

"She moves the puck well and she's really consistent," the netminder said.

McParland, whose brother Nick was the top sniper on last year's Oakville Blades junior A team that went to the RBC Royal Bank Cup national championship tournament, is attending Holy Trinity while playing for the Aeros. She'll play for Ontario Red.

The two Ontario squads will square off against one another to open the tournament Nov. 5. They will each play two more round-robin games over the next two days and the top two teams in each pool will advance to the semifinals.

The medal games will be played Nov. 9.
